WELCOME TO DISTRICT #6 WORLD OF HARE SCRAMBLES...

HERE ARE A FEW D-6 SPORTS ASSOCIATION RULES AND POLICIES FOR ALL HARE SCRAMBLE COMPETITORS TO KNOW AND UNDERSTAND.

D-6 NUMBERS

To retain your assigned number for the upcoming season your application must be received before January 31 of the current year. After this date your number is open to anyone who requests it. **No Exceptions** will be made regardless of the situation!!! Applications to renew numbers will not be accepted before December 1st of the current year. A photo copy of applicants birth certificate must accompany applications for anyone under 18 years of age.

If you request a different number than your previous assigned number, your application will be held until February 1st of the new year and your request will then be granted if the former holder of that number has not applied for it. If you have never had a D-6 Hare Scramble number assigned to you before (this does not mean a temporary number a track may have assigned) please write "none" in the block designated "previous number" on your application.

In order to receive a D-6 seasonal award you are required to have a D-6 Hare Scramble Card.

"C" Number Plates will be: Black with White Numbers.

"B" Number Plates will be: Yellow with Black Numbers.

"A" Number Plates will be: White with Black Numbers.

SIGN-IN – CLASSES and POINTS

To race you must show both your AMA and D-6 card at Sign-in. Failure to do so will result in having to re-apply and repaying of required fees. Always show your assigned number and respective classification on the entry bank. You may not cross class at any event. This will be strictly enforced and violators will be disqualified for the day. Any recurrence of crossing class lines may result in suspension of D-6 and AMA cards. An "A" moto-crosser must run in the "A" class in hare scrambles. The same motorcycle must be used for the entire event – no substitution of equipment allowed under any circumstances.

CLASSES WILL BE INDICATED BY A COLOR CODED SYSTEM AT DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.

TROPHY'S AND PAY-OFF TO "A" CLASS SHALL BE AWARDED AS PER CLASSES AND NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS.

POINTS DISTRIBUTION

1 ST -25 PTS	2 ND -22 PTS	3 RD - 20 PTS	4 TH -18PTS	5 TH - 16 PTS	6 TH - 15 PTS	7 TH - 14 PTS	8 TH - 13PTS	9 TH - 12PTS	10 TH -11PTS

D-6 Sports Association will award points to the top 20 overall finish position in each recognized class.

The winners will be determined by the rider completing the greatest number of laps within the designated time limit.

The course must be a minimum of 2.5 miles. Time limit shall be 2 hours for motorcycles, 1.5 hours for quads, 1 hour for mini motorcycles. 45 minutes youth quads and peewee. Time limit may be shortened if a safety hazard would happen to occur.

THE D-6 SPORTS ASSOCIATION POINTS SEASON RUNS FROM DECEMBER 1ST TO NOVEMBER 30TH

POINTS ADVANCEMENT SYSTEM:

B Riders who accumulate 300 points from the previous two seasons as a "B" will advance to the "A" class. "B" riders who accumulate the required 300 points may complete the current season as a "B" rider if he/she intends to compete for the D-6 seasonal "B" award, or the National Amateur Championship.

C Riders who accumulate 150 points from the previous season as a "C" will advance to the "B" class. "C" riders who accumulate the required 150 points may complete the current season as a "C" rider if he/she intends to compete for the D-6 seasonal "C" award, or the National Amateur Championship.

Each rider is responsible for keeping his/her own points record.

SCORING:

Riders MUST STOP at designated scoring area to be scored. Riders going thru the wrong lane or not slowing down will not be scored. It is also the responsibility of the rider and the promoter to make sure racers stop at the scoring area so they can be scored and that the promoter scores the rider properly. A rider must take the checkered flag or complete 50% of the laps of the leader of their class in order to receive points or awards. The promoter must have at least 1 back-up sheet for scoring lane. All riders must purchase and properly mount a transponder in order to be scored, it is the responsibility of the rider to make sure that the transponder is in working order before the race, and if not to be sure that he stops and his number is known at the scoring area.

FLAGS:

Halfway thru the event will be shown a crossed white and checkered flag at the specified time limit.

Finish – the finish of the event will be marked by a checkered flag at a specified time.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- STARTS SHALL BE DEAD ENGINE
- Changing the course during an event is allowed if it is to benefit the riders.
- Apparel and Equipment – a helmet is required and shatter proof goggles or face shield must be worn. A long sleeve shirt or jacket and boots, a minimum of eight inches high are required. Leather pants or approved moto cross pants must be worn.
- Hare Scramble events may NOT be started until qualified first aid crew and ambulance are present.

YOUTH CLASS MUST BE RUN AT A SEPARATE TIME FROM THE MAIN EVENT. ONE HOUR MAXIMUM TIME LIMIT.

* The following may be changed from stock: tires, wheels, internal portions of motor, sprockets, gearing, twist throttle, handlebars, grips, handle bar pads, front bumper, rear grab bar and jetting. Fenders may be trimmed. Nerf bars or suitable floorboards are required. No other modifications are allowed **INCLUDING** carburetors, exhaust systems, wheel base, width and suspension.
